**The goal** of studying the discipline *Political Science* is:

**educational** - students' acquisition of knowledge about socio-political processes, forms of government and state system, political parties and public associations, the role and place of the state in society;

**developing** - the formation and development of students' knowledge of the political structure of society, the ability to analyze political facts and events, the establishment of democratic standards of existence of society as a permanent consciousness;

**educational** - to promote the formation of values of students in accordance with the ideals of humanism, democracy, social justice, respect for the individual; education of an active civil position; formation of future specialists of political consciousness and political culture, professional and personal qualities.

Integral competencies of the bachelor, which must be formed during the study of the discipline: ZK2. Ability to apply knowledge in practical situations, ZK7. Ability to learn and master modern knowledge, ZK8. Ability to be critical and self-critical, ZK9. Ability to work in a team, ZK10. Ability to act on the basis of ethical considerations (motives), ZK11. The ability to exercise their rights and responsibilities as a member of society, to realize the values of civil (free democratic) society and the need for its sustainable development, the rule of law, human and civil rights and freedoms in Ukraine. ZK12. Ability to be aware of equal opportunities and gender issues. SK2. Knowledge and understanding of the retrospective of the formation of legal and state institutions. SK3. Respect for human honor and dignity as the highest social value, understanding of their legal nature.

**Prerequisites for the study of the discipline** were formed by mastering such disciplines as: History and Culture of Ukraine, Philosophy, Logic, Theory of State and Law, Sociology.

**The results** of the study of the discipline *Political Science*

According to the requirements of the educational program, Applicants must **know**:

1) *at the conceptual level*: political phenomena and values: political activity, political process, political power, political parties and public associations, political regime, political system, political leadership, political conflict, political culture, democracy, consensus, civil society;

2) *at the fundamental level*: object, subject and methods of *Political Science*, to own its conceptual and categorical apparatus;

3) *at the practical and creative level*: independently carry out a correct analysis and assessment of the political situation at the global and national levels.

**2. be able to:**

1) *at the reproductive level*: to use *Political Science*' categorical and terminological apparatus;

2) *at the algorithmic level*: to navigate in the current trends of political contexts in Ukraine and abroad;

3) *at the heuristic level*: to have the basics of political analysis;

4) *at the creative level*: to diagnose political processes, conflicts and find ways to harmonize them, to apply knowledge in practice and in professional activities, to expand the range of their knowledge about political processes and phenomena.

**Scope of the discipline:** 90 hours / 3 ECTS credits.

## **Curriculum of the academic program**

### **TOPIC 1. POLITICAL SCIENCE AS A SCIENCE AND EDUCATIONAL DISCIPLINE**

1. Political science as a science.
2. Political science as an academic discipline.
3. The place of political science in our everyday life.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: political doctrines. Historical factors in the emergence of politics: causes and approaches to clarifying the essence. Object and subject of the discipline. Political science as a science of politics. The main functions of policy. Basic methods of political science research. Logical errors in the study of political processes and phenomena. Specific features of the policy. Relationships of politics with other spheres of society. The driving forces of politics. Conflict, needs and interests in politics. Goals and tools in politics, their interaction.

Theoretical and empirical aspects of policy study. Laws, principles and categories of political science. The structure of political science. The main tasks and functions of political science. Methods of specific political science research. The importance of political science for the formation of political consciousness and political culture of students.

Skills to be developed and skills to be acquired during the lesson. Basic concepts of understanding the specifics of the course are formed. A conceptual and categorical apparatus is being developed.

### **TOPIC 2. HISTORY OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF WORLD POLITICAL THOUGHT**

1. Political thought of the ancient East, ancient Greece and Rome.
2. Political concepts in the Renaissance, Reformation, Enlightenment and modern times.
3. Political thought in the period XIX - first half of XX century.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: ancient East, Taoism, Confucianism, Legism, Antiquity, polis, politics, state, good, power, law, ideology, ideal state, tyranny, aristocracy, ochlocracy, oligarchy, politics, democracy direct, representative democracy, demos, despotism, republic, anthropocentrism, humanism, reformation.

Skills to be developed and skills to be acquired during the lesson The topic "History of World Political Thought" contributes to the formation of future professionals a systematic approach to understanding the genesis and political concepts in historical retrospect. Gives the opportunity to understand the evolution of political views of society in the context of socio-economic world transformations.

### **TOPIC 3. POLITICAL REGIMES**

1. The concept and nature of political regimes. Typological and essential features of political regimes.
2. The main types of political regimes: a) totalitarianism;

b) authoritarianism; c) democracy. 3. Basic concepts of democracy, forms of democracy.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: political regime, democratic regime, authoritarian regime, totalitarian regime, models of national authoritarianism, formation of authorities, methods of coercion and terror, human rights, centralization of power, political pluralism, elections.

The skills to be developed and the skills to be acquired during the session form the understanding of future professionals' understanding of the "correctness" and "incorrectness" of the political life of society. The historical context and examples of the existence of political regimes are designed to affirm the awareness of the value victories of democratic forms of society. The presentation of the negative consequences of totalitarian and authoritarian regimes reinforces the thesis of the introduction into public opinion of the idea of political and legal values that have developed in a civilized society.

#### **TOPIC 4. POLITICAL SYSTEM OF SOCIETY**

1. Conceptual concepts, content and features of the political system. 2. Typological characteristics of political systems. 3. Political systems: world experience and Ukrainian realities.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: political system, political loyalty, Anglo-American, European-continental, pre-industrial and partly industrial, totalitarian political systems, state, political organization of society.

The skills to be developed and the skills to be acquired during the study of the topic "Political system of society" is a basic element of political education of future employees. Forms in them an idea of the functioning of political and legal relations in the system of balancing state power.

#### **TOPIC 5. THE STATE AS A POLITICAL INSTITUTION**

1. The nature, characteristics and functions of the state. 2. The rule of law: the essence, basic features and principles. 3. Economic, social and national policy of a state.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: the state, the functions of the state, republic, monarchy, forms of government, unitary state, federal state, confederate state.

The skills to be developed and the skills to be acquired during the lesson form an idea of the state, the mechanisms of exercising power, economic and political, cultural, legal factors of modern society. Understanding the legitimacy and non-legitimacy of power and the system of checks and balances lays a solid foundation for democratic relations in society.

#### **TOPIC 6. CIVIL SOCIETY AND THE RULE OF LAW**

1. Civil society in the dimension of modern challenges. 2. The structure of civil society and its constituent elements. 3. The genesis of civil society in modern Ukrainian realities.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: civil society, functions of civil society, middle class, structure of civil society, responsibility of government and society, public control over the exercise of power, rule of law, branches of government, rule of law, rights and freedoms of citizens, impeachment.

Skills to be developed and skills to be acquired during the lesson to form an idea of the state, the mechanisms of government, economic and political, cultural, legal factors of modern society. Distinguishing between the factors of legitimacy and non-legitimacy of power and the system of deterrence - counterbalances lays a solid foundation for democratic relations in society.

## **TOPIC 7. ELECTIONS TO POLITICAL AUTHORITIES**

1. Functions of elections: the democratic dimension. 2. Organizational principles and implementation of suffrage. 3. Election campaigns. Methodology of conducting. 4. Majority and proportional system.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: state power, presidential, parliamentary, municipal elections, regular and early elections, election functions, political socialization of the population, civil society, electoral qualifications, manipulations, electoral systems, majority, proportional, mixture systems, the electoral system in Ukraine.

Skills to be developed and skills to be acquired during the lesson of mastering the basic constitutional and legislative requirements for the organization and conduct of elections. Form your attitude to falsifications and all kinds of abuses during the election process. Become a supporter of the legality of free will of citizens during the election process.

## **TOPIC 8. POLITICAL PARTIES AND NON-GOVERNMENTAL ASSOCIATIONS**

1. Political parties: the genesis of development and typology. 2. Party systems. Typology of party systems. 3. The party system of modern Ukraine: the genesis and problems of formation.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: Terminological definitions of "party". Historical features and examples of party functioning. Parties as a social phenomenon. The main features of political parties. Purpose and functions of political parties. Legislative regulation of their activities. The interest of society in the legal acts of parties. Political struggle for power. Functions of political recruitment.

The main types of political parties (cadre, mass, avant-garde, parliamentary, ruling and opposition, right, left, centrist). World experience of functioning of political parties. Characteristic features of political parties. Membership in a political

party. Varieties of party systems (one-party, two-party, rich party). Party systems in terms of international functioning.

Features of the party system in Ukraine. The emergence of multiparty system and the problems of its formation in Ukraine. Political parties in modern Ukraine. Legislative support for the activities of political parties.

The skills to be developed and the skills to be acquired during the lesson to form in the minds of future professionals the permanence of the democratic foundations of society. To provide an opportunity to determine one's civic position and to help with orientation in modern political conflicts of society. Consider the activities of political forces in terms of their legality and legitimacy.

### **TOPIC 9. POLITICAL ELITES AND POLITICAL LEADERSHIP**

1. The concept, genesis and features of political elitism. 2. Political elites: concepts and functions of elites. 3. Political leadership: genesis, characteristics, typology and main functions. 4. Ukrainian politics in the dimension of elitism and political leadership.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: political elite, functions of political elites, national elites, political leader, theories of political leadership, typologies of leadership.

Skills to be developed and skills to be acquired during the lesson to form an understanding of political and legal transformations in modern society. Use a critical and constructive mechanism for evaluating its activities. Establish consistent assessments in determining the effectiveness of the exercise of political power.

### **TOPIC 10. INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS AND FOREIGN POLICY OF THE STATE**

The concept of the content and essence of foreign policy. The structure of world politics. Types of foreign policy. Purpose, types and scope of international relations. Geopolitical situation of the country. The main problems of world politics.

Basic concepts, terms and categories to be mastered: international politics, foreign policy, world politics, geopolitics, the United Nations, globalism, global issues of today, international relations.

The skills to be developed and the skills to be acquired during the class The free orientation of future specialists in this field of knowledge will give them the opportunity to determine their own civic position on the path of reforming modern society.

### **Form of the assessment of the learning success**

Final control is a test of the level of acquisition of knowledge, skills, abilities and other competencies for the academic semester.

The general rating of the applicant's competence consists of ratings on educational work (classroom, independent, individual) and final control (credit).

Thus the maximum rating on educational work makes 60, and final control - 40 points.

The overall rating of the applicant's competence is thus assessed on a 100-point scale.

Individual applicants for active participation in sports and mass or scientific work, according to the decision of the department, can be awarded, within 100 points, additional points, but not more than 20.

If the applicant has not scored the minimum number of points for academic work (40) or his overall rating of competence was less than 60 points, he is considered to have an academic debt.

To obtain points for independent and individual work, the applicant must perform tasks on each topic: abstracts, essays, presentations.

Assessment on a particular topic (task) is carried out on the following scale: "excellent" - 5 points, "good" - 4 points, "satisfactory" - 3 points, "unsatisfactory" - 2 points.

For the discipline *Political Science* special means of diagnosing the knowledge of learning success are the delivery of control standards.

In the case of restrictive quarantine measures for the study of the discipline *Political Science*, the final control measures are compiled remotely, using the course management system (CMS) Moodle.

Credit in the discipline *Political Science* can be conducted in the form of tests. Test tasks consist of 40 questions on the topics provided by the Work program of the discipline *Political Science* for the academic year. Each test question contains 4 answer options, from which you must choose one. For all test questions, the correct answer is one. One correct answer is evaluated in one point.

To successfully pass the test / exam and get a positive assessment, the applicant must score a minimum number of points - 20. The maximum number of points for the test - 40.

Examination control will be carried out on the day determined by the schedule of the credit-examination session, from 9.00 o'clock. until 17.00 The total number of questions to be addressed - 40 (with topics that were worked out during the semester).

80 minutes are allotted for testing (credit / exam), after which access to testing will be closed.

The obtained points are added to those set by the teacher for classroom, independent and individual work.

Those students who did not receive the required amount of points as a result of passing the test / exam, will be given the opportunity to re-pass. The day of re-assembly is determined by the dean's office of the faculty, the information about it will be reported by the methodologist.
